OUR PURPOSE

DISTRIBUTING OPEN-POLLINATED SEEDS EXCLUSIVELY FROM ORGANIC FARMING

In 4 missions :

1. Ensure seed and food sovereignty by distributing open-pollinated seeds accessible to all !
2. Support biodiversity protection by preserving a unique seed range for its vitality and varietal purity.
3. Act as true whistleblowers by encouraging the consumption of local, organic, F1-hybrid-free and GMO-free products !
4. Promote the cultivation and use of medicinal plants, used for millennia but often banned, within home remedies.

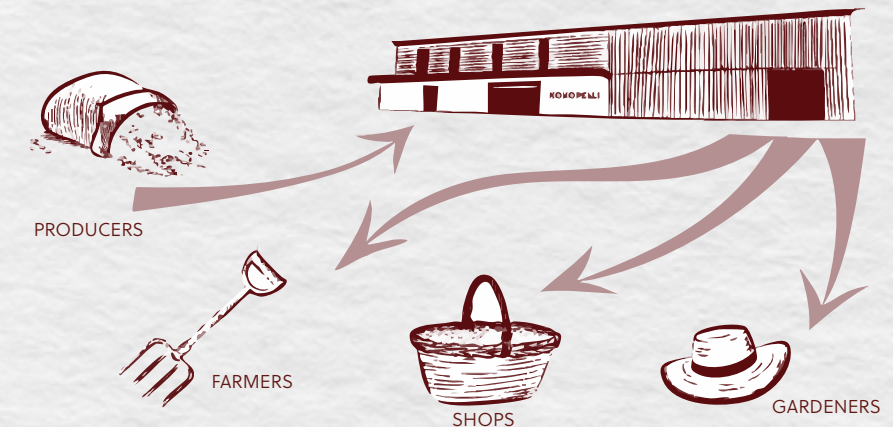
Every year, we showcase a medicinal plant by distributing thousands of free seed packets.

WHERE ARE OUR SEEDS PRODUCED ?

Our seeds come from our professional network of seed producers and multipliers, mainly based in France, complemented by long-standing partners in neighboring countries. We manage the entire production plan and ensure both the varietal purity and the quality of the seeds we offer.

A clear origin that highlights the value of "local."



THE QUALITY OF OUR SEEDS

A 100% ORGANIC RANGE

Exclusively certified Organic Farming, free from chemicals, pesticides, fungicides, and synthetic fertilizers.

THE TRACEABILITY OF OUR SEEDS

To further our commitment to transparency, a tool traces the production origin and the most recent germination test.

This tool allows gardeners, simply by scanning the QR code on the back of the packet, to see the latest germination rate and learn about the producer who multiplied the seeds..

Transparency, from seed to seed, is one of our founding value.

A GERMINATION RATE HIGHER THAN THE LEGAL STANDARD

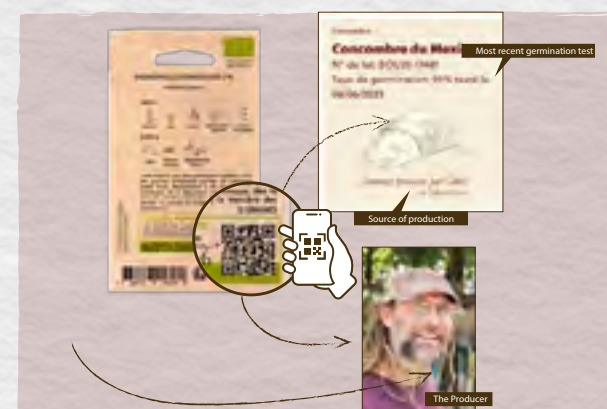
Le taux de germination est systématiquement mesuré à l'arrivée de chaque lot de semences. Le résultat du test obtenu est apposé au dos des sachets.

1. The germination rate is systematically measured upon the arrival of each seed batch. The test result is printed on the back of the packets.
2. If a batch does not meet the expected result, it is not put on sale.

We are committed to achieving germination rates well above the legal standards.

A few examples of the minimum germination capacities required by Directive 2002/55/EC compared with those required by Kokopelli :

Species	Minimum germination rate	
	Directive 2002/55/EC	At Kokopelli
Aubergine	65%	85%
Poivron / Piment	65%	80%
Radis	70%	90%
Tomate	75%	90%



Our packets are made of kraft paper, biodegradable, and plastic-free, thus reducing environmental impact. They provide ideal conditions for seed preservation.
